A video series for teens who are thinking about sex...

What's Next? is a new video series for teens who are thinking about, talking about and making decisions about sex. This four-part dramatic series features a multi-racial company of young actors tackling relationships and sexual decision making head-on. Each video is approximately 25 minutes long.

What's Next? is youth-driven and youth-tested — featuring teens and caring adults in dramatic, realistic and engaging stories that “go to kids where they are” — with language, music, visual style and real-world settings.

“Angel of Mine” Erica and Jay should have talked it over — now they are dealing with the consequences of unintended pregnancy.

“Lookin’ Out 4 U” Cori, Isobel and Nikki are all caught up in the downward spiral of an abusive relationship. Can they break the cycle before they really get hurt?

“Countdown” It's only a matter of time before one of these people contracts HIV — a frank and provocative exploration of risk. *for release in 2003

“Cyber-real” An Internet chat room deception leads to a crime that forever changes the life of a lonely teen — a cutting-edge story of stranger danger based on today's headlines. *for release in 2003
